

# Magnetic Letter Sorting

Print out the [magnetic letter sorting sheets](#) you would like to use with your students. Laminate the sheets or place them in dry erase pockets for durability.

Set out a sorting sheet or two, along with a variety of magnetic letters. Explain to the kids that they are going to be sorting the letters. They need to be real letter detectives and make sure to look at each letter before sorting it. Model how to sort one or two letters before having the children do so themselves.

As the letters are being sorted, talk to the kids about the different shapes within each letter. Once the sorting sheets are full, engage in a discussion about which column had more (along with any other observations the kids might have).

This activity can be done on a cookie sheet or on a vertical, magnetic easel. It can also just be done on a table.

Depending on the needs of your students, you might just want to start out with a small amount of letters.


